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

- One of the highest median incomes in the US: \$73,433
- "Only" 21% of population on Medicaid

Affordability Two Connecticuts

 40% of Connecticut households fall under the income threshold for meeting basic needs (ALICE)




Affordability Disparities

"The impact of ... economic pressures on workers and their families is widespread and disproportionately affects women and people of color. Despite some recent signs that Connecticut's economy is growing and wages for low-wage workers are increasing, working families continue to struggle to reach a decent standard of living."

Affordability State Budget Challenges



- Huge budget deficits:
 - Projected \$1.9 billion in 2020,
 - Projected \$2.5 billion in 2021
- State employee and retiree health benefits, pensions
- Medicaid: \$2.6 billion annual budget

It's the Prices Stupid: Focus on Prices and Monopoly Power

Hospitals

- Consolidation and market power to raise prices
- Rate setting; reference pricing

Insurance

- Mega-mergers
- Affordability to consumers in rate review

Prescription drugs

- Transparency and price gouging
- Relief from unaffordable out-of-pocket costs

 Connecticut Residents Worried about High Drug Costs—Express Bipartisan Support for a Range of Government Solutions




Two Bites at the Apple (so far)

- Paper with Yale Global Health Justice Partnership and National Physicians Alliance: Curbing Unfair Drug Prices, A Primer for States
- Health Care Cabinet studies prescription drug costs

- Cabinet reports recommendations
- Transparency legislation drafted



50% of Connecticut adults experienced a problem with health care affordability in the last year.


